Dear Friend of PCF,

**G**reetings! Here at PCF we have embraced a new year with full arms. Our prayer has been to fulfill our vision statement; ***to be a family of God to extend the Kingdom of God.*** We have been asking God what that looks like.

We have felt God challenging us to help spread the Word of God in Prague. We'd like to introduce the **Bible Project 2014** to you. We pray that your church will consider helping us to purchased Bibles.

## Background

Last year a friend asked her church to send PCF \$500 for the purchase of Bibles. We were able to buy and easily distribute the Bibles during events and outreaches (Czech / English Bible 21). We saw that there is a great lack here. The time is right for this project because:

- In the last few years, 3 **new translations** of the Bible have been published here which has brought the Word of God into the media spotlight and sparked interest.
- There are **only 0.8% evangelical Christians** in the Czech Republic. Some Czechs have a very old version of the Bible in their library, but they have never read it.
- There are other people groups living in Prague that are unreached and have never even seen a Bible, including over 60,000 **Vietnamese** people living in the Czech Republic, making them the third largest minority after Ukrainians and Slovaks. The community has grown more than threefold since 2001, the time of the last census.
- Youth With a Mission Prague (several members of PCF) coordinates street outreaches. There is a need for **Bulgarian** Bibles for the prostitutes who would like a Bible in their own language.

## Goal for 2014

**Our goal is to find 20 churches that will donate \$250 for the purchase of Czech, English, Vietnamese and Bulgarian Bibles** for us to distribute on a personal basis. Our own members have already begun to give towards the purchase of Bibles, as there is a tremendous demand. Of course, a gift of any amount would be greatly appreciated. 100 % of funds will go directly to purchasing Bibles.
